



## Certified Applicator Specialist Crew

### Introduction

Certified Applicator Specialist Crew consists of skilled workers assigned to a project for the purpose of applying CerarMist. The crew is distinguished from other types of cleaning and sanitizing applicators due to the unique protection factor delivered when using the CerarMist products.

### Job Descriptions

**Crew Chief:** A crew may be comprised of one or more CAS specialist. If a team is present then the appointed supervisor must accurately supervise the crew regarding all matters of proper equipment use, application, safety, quality control, cleanup and documentation including the following:

**Each CAS** is required to:

- ✓ Know all of the necessary principals of the CerarMist application process in various types of conditions and performs all functions of the process in a professional manner.
- ✓ Operates and maintains various types of equipment such as electrostatic spray guns, foggers, and compressors, ladders, scaffolding and motorized lifts as well as having the ability to troubleshoot as appropriate.
- ✓ Be attentive to the operating environment and to respect the company equipment and any adjacent customer property.
- ✓ Be on constant alert for any occupational hazards and be prepared to take appropriate precautionary measures to assure everyone's health safety.
- ✓ Be able to erect, work on and dismantle scaffolding, remove or cover objects, clean work areas, and maintain tools, and other equipment.
- ✓ Load, unload, prepare and cleanup of job site, materials and tools.
- ✓ Performs all equipment in the application of CerarMist as well as equipment care, maintenance and repair procedures.

## Skills and Abilities

- Follow established policies and procedures and work within precise limits.
- Organization and self-motivation.
- Practice time management skills
- Comprehend oral and written English instruction.
- Work independently within a team environment to assist others as needed.
- Ability to repetitively push, pull and lift above shoulder height.
- Possess good manual dexterity and hand-eye coordination.
- Ability to work easily and skillfully with hands.
- Ability to work in various environments and confined spaces.
- Work closely with other team leaders to ensure the timely application of CerarMist required to meet production schedules.
- Adapt to rapidly changing priorities based on business needs.
- Pass physical with drug screen.

## Duties and Tasks

- Utilize safety, health and environmental rules and regulations, policies and procedures
- Perform preliminary project on-site inspections.
- Perform surface preparation techniques for various surfaces using industry standard tools and equipment such as by washing, treating, scraping to ensure CerarMist protectant will adhere properly.
- Equipment selection, operation of ladders, scaffolding, scissor and boom lifts as necessary to work above ground level.
- Perform CerarMist estimating and ordering.
- Identify, select and prepare CerarMist protectant for project specific requirements.
- Operate equipment and perform maintenance and repair procedures on-site.
- Prepare proper project specific documentation.
- Climb and maintain balance on ladders and scaffolds, and stand, stoop, kneel, or crouch while applying CerarMist.
- Identify and secure potential CerarMist projects.
- Clean, maintain and store tools and equipment, cleans work sites.
